



BULA DESIGN: Ania Pauser • Handwoven rug in pure new wool from New Zealand



BULA is a handwoven wool rug with woven dots of pile emerging like bumps from the smooth surface. - The irregular cluster of dots creates a sensation of movement and gives a tactile feel when you walk on the rug. Depending on the colours, the rug is suitable for elegant environments as well as for adding a playful touch, perhaps to a child's room. The rug is stocked in the colour white. Possible to custom order your own colour combination. The ground colour is selected from Allium colours. The dots are unicolour selected from Sencillo colours.

Product: Handwoven rug in 100% pure new high quality wool from New Zealand.
Weft material: Wool
Warp material: Linen
Backing: Not reversible
Finish: Woven hemmed linen edge
Height: approx. 8 mm/15 mm
Weight: approx. 1900 g/m²
Sizes: 170 x 240
Custom orders: Possible, maximum width 400 cm, maximum length 1000 cm

Other information:

- Size variations for handmade rugs +/-5%.
- We use renewable natural materials. Dye lot and yarn batch variations can occur.
- Traditionally, wool rugs have been woven on linen warp. We have chosen to weave on linen warp for stability and better durability.
- We recommend rug underlay: For reduced wear, improved comfort, non-slip properties and easier vacuuming.
