HERRINGBONE WILD The Herringbone pattern is an arrangement of blocks used since the antiquity in floor tilings and road pavements as well as in textiles of all sorts. This hand tufted pile and loop rug, with “wild” pile heights, offers a lush, natural touch to a room. The pile is 70 mm high, and the material is composed of 70% hard twisted worsted New Zealand wool and 30% twisted linen. The colour options are the same as for our Camelia collection.

Product: Hand tufted rug in 70% hard twisted worsted wool from New Zealand and 30% linen.

Material: Hard twisted worsted wool and linen

Base fabric: Polyester

Backing material: Cotton and polyester

Adhesive: Synthetic latex

Number of threads in needle: 2/3

Finish: Edged with band

Pile height: approx. 70 mm

Total height: approx. 74 mm

Weight: approx. 4400 g/m²

Sizes: Custom. Round, square or rectangular.

Maximum width 500 cm, maximum length 1300 cm.

Other information:

- Size variations for handmade rugs +/- 5 %
- We use renewable natural materials. Dye lot and yarn batch variations may occur.
- Pile shedding during first period of use is normal.
